TIME FOR CAMP!

CPS Elementary will be moving to Camp Ozanam June 9, 10, 11. Please read the following notes regarding important transportation information.

- If your child walks to school, a bus will leave for Camp Ozanam at 7:45 AM each day.
- Walkers and students being picked up will return at 2:55/3:00 on Wednesday and Thursday.
- On FRIDAY the return bus will arrive at 11:50/11:55 AM at the elementary.
- CPS Handbook will remain in effect at Camp Ozanam.

NOTE: Please **DO NOT** drop off or pick children up at Camp. Meet the bus in the morning and at the end of day at the elementary school. This is important due to limited parking at Camp and to ensure the safety of our students. Thank you for your cooperation.
